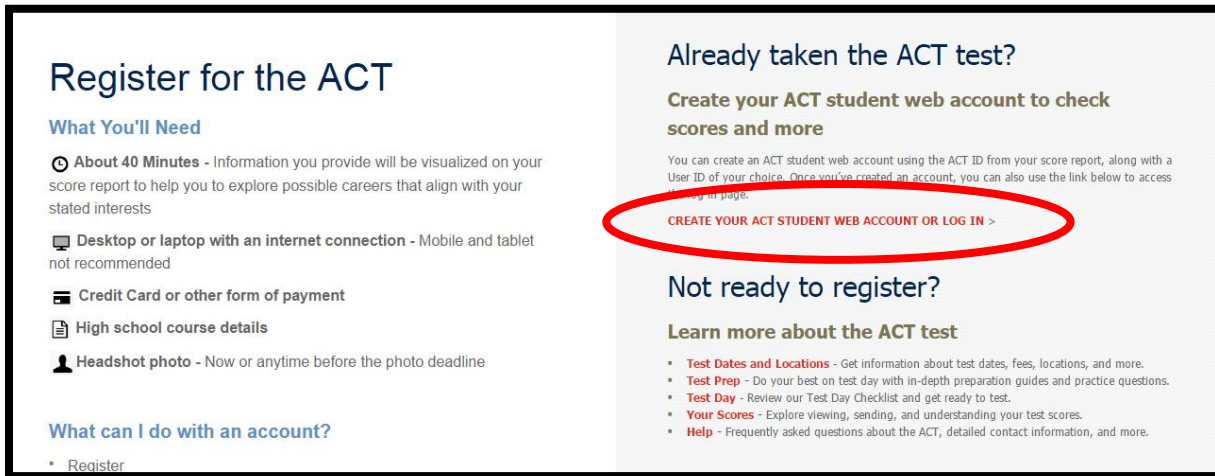


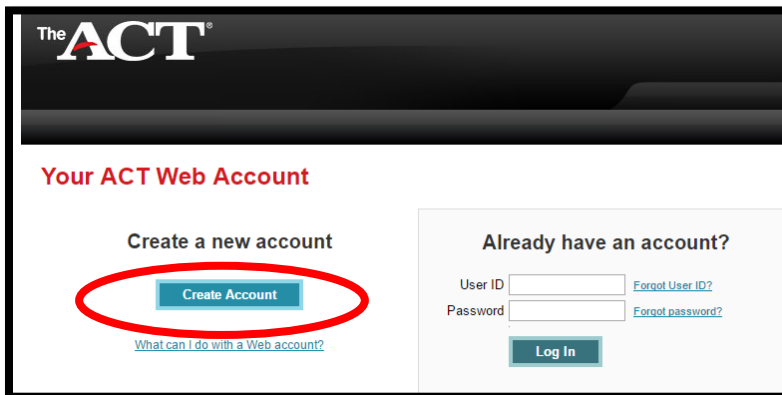
Creating an ACT Account with ACT ID

To be able to send your ACT scores to colleges and for the NCAA Eligibility Center, or to register for future ACT tests, you must create an account using your unique ACT ID that was printed at the top of your score sheet. To set up an account, complete the following steps:

1. Go to www.actstudent.org
2. Click on the button that says "Register, View Scores, and More"
3. On the right side of the screen, click "Create Your ACT Student Web Account or Log In"



4. Click "Create Account"



5. Select the following options: Have you registered for ACT = NO; Have you taken the ACT before = YES
