Registration Dates: **January 7** (opens 12:01am) - **March 1** (closes 11:59pm)

How to Register:

1. Go to: www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/443535
2. Complete Demographic Information for you and your parent
3. Select test AND teacher for each test **OR**
 - Select "Independent study" if you are re-taking an AP Exam **OR** If you are taking an exam for a class you are not currently enrolled in.
4. Select a pre-administration session. Students are required to attend a pre-administration session.
5. Complete Payment:
 - Use a Credit Card **OR**
 - Print invoice and mail with a CASHIER'S Check to "Total Registration"

\$76 Total cost Regular Registration (\$98 - \$22 Cypress Ridge Scholarship*)

\$25 Total cost F/R Lunch Students (\$57- \$24 State Scholarship - \$8 Cypress Ridge Scholarship*)

LATE REGISTRATION: March 2 (12:01AM Midnight) through March 8 (11:59am NOON).

- You will be charged a \$10 late fee during this time.
- Total late registration cost is \$86 per exam and \$35 for students on Free/Reduced Lunch.
- After March 8 (11:59am **NOON**), students are no longer able to register for exams.

Refund Deadline:

Full Refund Date: Fri, Mar 1, 2019, - Date by which students may receive a full refund of \$76 for regular registration and \$25 for F/R students.

Partial Refund Date: If requested by, Mar 8, 2019 11:59am - May Cancel an exam with a cancellation fee of \$35. \$41.00 refund for regular registration and no refund for F/R students.
