- Online registration will begin on Tuesday, August 27 at 12:01AM and end on Friday, October 4 at 11:59pm.

- Cost: \$22.00
- 11th Grade Students on Free/Reduced Lunches must request a fee waiver while registering online. Cost \$0. \*A LIMITED NUMBER OF FEE WAIVERS FOR STUDENTS ON FREE/REDUCED LUNCHES ARE AVAILABLE. SIGN-UP EARLY!!
- **10th Grade students are NOT eligible for fee waivers.**
- Have your credit/debit card ready. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the PDF of the confirmation page that is provided at the end.
- Monday, Sept. 30 - Last day to cancel an exam and receive a full refund of \$22.
- No refunds on or after October 1.
- Friday, October 4 - Payment must be received by Total Registration. All Un-paid registrations may be cancelled.

**\*Late Registration** - Space available basis ONLY – October 7-11. \$26 payable in cash, in person, to the Counseling Office. NO FEE WAIVERS WILL BE ISSUED DURING THIS TIME.

The PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) is given nationally ONLY ONE time a year. We encourage sophomores to take the PSAT to experience the testing environment and practice taking a standardized test. Juniors should take the PSAT for the above reasons, as well as a "route-of-entry to NMSC (National Merit Scholarship Corporation) scholarship competitions." Juniors and are encouraged to take the PSAT BOTH their sophomore and junior years.

#### By taking the PSAT/NMSQT, JUNIORS can:

- Enter the National Merit Scholarship competition and other scholarship competitions
- Practice for SAT Reasoning Test (College Entrance Exam)
- Request colleges to send information about programs, activities, and financial aid
- Students who qualify as National Merit or National Hispanic Scholars will be recognized
- with a nameplate on the National Scholar plaque in front of the Counseling Office.

#### By taking the PSAT/NMSQT, SOPHOMORES can:

- Practice for PSAT/SAT Reasoning Test
- Request colleges to send information about programs activities, and financial aid Be selected by the district for the Scholars Program
